

The Naismith Coaches Circle honors the first coach, Dr. James Naismith. The core values he integrated into the game are the foundation by which young men and women play the game and conduct their lives. The Hall of Fame created this program to recognize coaches who have made a difference by teaching and mentoring with these values in mind.

This program offers the opportunity to honor Coach Yow and showcase those that inspired her and those that she inspired. You can pay tribute permanently in the Naismith Circle Courtyard with an engraved granite bench for Coach Yow.

In addition, her inspirational story will be included in the Hall's digital & interactive Coaches Circle Exhibit which is located on the second floor inside the Museum.





Exterior Courtyard Exhibit - Naismith Granite Benches

Located in the Naismith Circle Courtyard, these beautifully engraved granite basketball shaped benches surround the memorial statue of James Naismith. Placed at the main entrance, they are the first impression for over 1 million guests who visit the Hall of Fame property each year.

Each bench has its own unique message – customized by (or for) the coach it celebrates.


We look forward to working with you and Coach Yow's family to create a message that reflects and honors her journey.
